Dear Potential Stall Holder,

The Otago University Students' Association holds one market day each month of the University Year. The markets start at 9am and will run through to 4:00pm outside on the Union Lawn. We provide tables and chairs on a **first come first serve basis**, but we recommend that you bring your own. Tables must be returned to the area where you collected them and they must be folded, as you found them. Power is not available. You are not allowed food and drink stalls at market day.

Table and chairs are delivered at 8am and there is a limit of **4 tables per stall payment**. We do not book particular sites, so if you desire a specific area we advise you to arrive early. If you bring a vehicle to campus, you will also need to arrive early so that you will be able to find a park near to the University. By 9:00am most parks are gone!

YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO PARK ON CAMPUS. THE UNIVERSITY WILL TOW OFFENDING VEHICLES.

We hope the weather is fine, but should it rain you have the option of taking a site in the Union Hall or having your money refunded.

We prefer that Market Day sites are paid for prior to the event, at OUSA or by sending a cheque to OUSA, however payments on the day will be accepted.
