Memorandum Parties

Between Dive Otago Limited and Otago University Scuba Dive Club. Dive Otago will:

- 1.1. provide organisational services to the **Otago University Scuba Dive Club** as a sub-club to the regular Dive Otago Club
- 1.2. provide indirect oversight for diving activities, recommendations and answer any questions on diving day
- 1.3. create and maintain a booking system for club dives
- 1.4. rent equipment that has been tested in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendation
- 1.5. All tanks are provided with Air that has been delivered by a compressor with a current Air Purity certificate
- 1.6. oversee the screening of all divers for competency before diving (coldwater experience, skill currency, and certification)
- 1.7. provide a free checkout dive session at the beginning of each semester
- 1.8. where available the facility can be booked for movies nights and post-dive BBQs
- 1.9. provide Level 4 training scholarships to help the club with succession leadership planning
- 1.10. provide equipment and course discounts to club members
- 1.11. look at assisting the club in the procurement of a set of non-technical club equipment that students can utilise and reduce barriers to participation
- 1.12. will provide services at a rate disclosed in schedule 2
- 1.13. provide hire equipment only where and when it is available on a day hire basis
- 1.14. will maintain the safety credentials listed in schedule 1

2. Otago University Scuba Dive Club will:

- 2.1. make sure divers on club days will provide their own mask, snorkel, boots and gloves
- 2.2. organise all social aspects of the club
- 2.3. promote the club within the university
- 2.4. encourage safe dive practices at all times
- 2.5. ensure dive otago gear is returned cleaned and any breakages or faults are reported
- 2.6. Report any breaches in safe diving practices or breaches to the Dive Otago Membership Agreement
- 2.7. Support Dive Otago in terms of promoting equipment sold in the retail facility
- 2.8. Not enter into direct equipment sales to students as a conflict of interest to Dive Otago
