WHO QUALIFIES FOR A UNIQUE CODE AND HOW DO THEY OBTAIN THIS?

### 5 DIFFERENT TYPES OF UNIQUE CODES:

- Hyde St Resident
- Invited by Hyde St Resident
- Clyde St Resident (parallel to Hyde)
- Leith St Resident (parallel to Hyde)
- Other Registration (Albany & Fredrick St backing on to Hyde St)

## INVITED BY A HYDE STREET RESIDENT UNIQUE CODE

x8 'Invited by a Hyde Street Resident' unique codes are given to each Hyde St Residents to invite their friends on Monday 9th April. A wristband is only guaranteed once the unique code is registered and paid for.

## CLYDE ST, LEITH ST & OTHER REGISTRATION UNIQUE CODES

The OUSA team will go around the surrounding streets that back on to Hyde St to drop off a code for each resident on Tuesday 10th April. This includes residents on the opposite side of the backing streets around Hyde St. If you are not home, you will find a flyer to bring to OUSA Main Office along with your tenancy agreement to receive your unique codes.

#### **ONLINE REGISTRATION + PAYMENT**

Everyone that received a unique code will need to go to hydestreet.co.nz to register their details and pay online by 4pm Thursday 12th April. To register, you must be:

- A current NZ Tertiary Student
- 18 Years or Older
- Have valid age ID + Student ID

All unclaimed codes will be release to General Admission Ballot and the code will not be allowed to be claimed.

### GENERAL ADMISSION

IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE OR QUALIFY FOR A UNIQUE CODE, YOU CAN REGISTER FOR THE GENERAL ADMISSION LOTTERY.

#### **SELECTION PROCESS**

You can choose to register individually or as a group (up to 5 people) however in the selection process, if a group registers and 1 person from that group is randomly selected, all of the group will be selected as well, so you will have more chance as a bigger group. You may also only register once, all subsequent duplicate registrations will be deleted (including if you have a Unique Code registered, your General Admission registration will be deleted).

#### **RANDOM SELECTION**

Once General Admission is closed, duplicates will be deleted, and random selection will take place.

#### **ALL EMAILS SENT**

All Successful + Unsuccessful emails will be sent to all registered students by 5pm Friday 13th April. If successful, an individual link will be sent to complete the registration and payment process. This must be completed by 4pm Tuesday 17th April to secure a wristband. A reminder email will be sent to all unregistered students on Monday 16th April.

#### **ONLINE REGISTRATION + PAYMENT**

If successful registration and payment is not complete, another lottery will be drawn for remaining unclaimed wristbands and successful emails will be sent out by 6pm Tuesday 17th April. They will have 4pm Wednesday 18th April to complete registration and payment to secure a wristband.

#### **RECEIVE CONFIRMATION EMAIL OF PAYMENT AND REGISTRATION SUCCESS**

All unique codes and General Admission registrations are non-refundable, non-exchangeable and non-transferable!

#### WRISTBAND COLLECTION

Collect wristband with registered Student ID + Age ID on Thursday 19th or Friday 20th April at the OUSA Main Office (640 Cumberland St) between 9am – 5pm

If this is not possible, Event day collection from OUSA Clubs & Societies Building (84 Albany Street) will be available 9am – 1pm with registered Student ID + Age ID.
