



INFO ABOUT COMPETITION

OUSA + Dispensary have teamed up for Art Week 2018 to host a reusable cup design competition!

We want to incorporate the important message of sustainability by making reusable travel mugs more accessible and desirable to students to invest in and continue to use instead of the standard disposable takeaway cup.

Both students and non-students are encouraged to design their own reusable takeaway cup any way you want, so you can continue to use it and the potential to earn some sweet prizes!

We will have low cost plain ceramic reusable mugs available to purchase if you need, however if you already have your own, you are most welcome to design and enter this instead - just no disposable coffee cups!

You can choose any medium you like but paints and permanent markers might be your choice, so they will last the test of time and we will have some special ceramic markers to use at Dispensary. Each design entered will also receive a free coffee - so there is nothing to lose and everything to gain!

Once entries close on Friday 3 August, all reusable cups will be displayed at Dispensary over Art Week (6-10 August) where customers will receive a token to vote for their favourite design.

RULES

Both students and non-students can enter this competition and each entry will receive a free coffee voucher to use at Dispensary.

You can design and enter any reusable takeaway cup (plastic, ceramic, glass etc.). You don't have to use the ceramic reusable cups available, however we will not accept disposable coffee cups, as we want to encourage the use of reusable cups.

The Reusable Cup Design Competition submissions will be accepted from Monday 9th July 2018 - 3pm Friday 3rd August 2018.

All entries must be their own original work and must not breach any copyrights.

All entries must be left at Dispensary from 3rd - 12th August 2018 to be displayed for voting by customers over Art Week, but will still remain property of the entry person where they can collect after the display week.

Any mediums can be used for the reusable takeaway cup design, however we encourage creating something permanent and washable so that the cup can be utilised and reused.

Photos may be taken of the reusable cup designs for promotional purposes, but we will ensure credit is given to the artist if done so.

TIMELINE

HOW TO DESIGN YOUR CUP:

MARKERS

Ceramic pens (oil based permanent markers) are your best way to go, as they will last the longest. Once your design is finished, dry for 24 hours, place in a cold oven, heat to 170 degrees before baking for 30 minutes. That way they can handle a dishwasher if you want to continuously use your cup art. Unfortunately, your classic sharpie won't do the trick, so make sure it is oil based! We will be leaving some ceramic pens at Dispensary for people to use, so get creative!

3D ART

You can also create a 3D effect with porcelain outline paint that you can get from craft places like Spotlight. Just leave it to dry overnight and you can bake it to last longer.

PAINT

You can use porcelain paint (or add water to create a watercolour effect) on your cup. After you have finished your design, dry for 24 hours, place in a cold oven, heat to 170 degrees before baking for 30 minutes.

NAIL POLISH

You can try to either paint your art on with nail polish or even try a marble effect. You will need a deep water filled container with drops of nail polish colours on top to create the desired effect. You can then dip your cups into this, clean edges with nail polish remover and let dry.

CHALKBOARD PAINT

You can use chalkboard paint to create a black surface to do your design on or paint over more easily. Once painted, dry for 24 hours, place in a cold oven, heat to 150 degrees before baking for 30 minutes.
