Happy Moose 24 Hour Speed Photo Competition 2018 Rules & Guidelines

This competition is about speed and creativity, the goal is to inspire participants to create their best images within a short amount of time. Get your friends together, play with lighting, or find a pretty landscape and use this as an excuse to explore Dunedin, just grab a camera and have fun. Most of all you have the freedom to tell whatever story you'd like!



Rules:

You will have 24 hours to produce your best 2 photos to enter into 1 of the 3 categories of Best Landscape, Best Portrait (subject) + Best Open category. A winner from each category will be chosen. However, both of your entries don't have to fall into the same category.

Photos must be in .JPEG file format

You can photograph in any format, just the submitted photo must be .JPEG

Your camera's date and time should be set correctly

To show that the photo was made within the given time frame.

• Ensure that your camera is using the highest resolution available

Not mandatory, but will look nice when presented, this isn't a consideration when judging.

Editing is permitted

But remember, this is about your creativity with a camera and creating a story with what's available to you.

Photos must have been made within 24 hours

The time stamp on the photo may be checked, if there is none, it's at the judge's' discretion whether the entry is valid.

• Use your full name to name each photo file

Please save each file using "*Your Name* 1" and "*Your Name* 2" for each image.

The contest starts at 2 p.m. Thursday 9 August and all photographs must be submitted by 2 p.m. Friday 10 August. Any photographs made before or after this time period will not be considered. To submit your chosen 1 or 2 photos, please use one of the following options:
