1. Purpose

- 1.1. The Executive Conduct Subcommittee exists to:
- 1.2. Provide recommendations to the Executive when there has been a breach of the Executive Code of Conduct as stipulated in the Executive Discipline policy.

2. Membership

- 2.1. The Membership of the committee shall consist of the:
 - 2.1.1. President;
 - 2.1.2. Administrative Vice-President; and;
 - 2.1.3. Finance and Strategy Officer.
- 2.2. In cases where the Conduct Committee is meeting to discuss any of the Executive Officers listed in clauses 2.1, the Academic Representative shall stand in their place.

3. Terms of Reference

- 3.1. The subcommittee shall receive a summary of the misconduct from the President;
- 3.2. In cases of the President, the Administrative Vice-President and the Finance and Strategy officer shall act in reference to the President.
- 3.3. The Committee shall make a verbal recommendation to the Executive;
- 3.4. The Committee shall be held entirely in confidential committee.
- 3.5. They shall act in good faith, unbiased and be fair.
