1. Purpose

- 1.1. The Submissions Committee exists to:
 - 1.1.1. Provide feedback, advice and direction on submissions written by the Political Representative.

2. Interpretation

- 2.1. In this policy, unless the context otherwise requires:
- 2.2. Committee means the Submissions Committee; and;
- 2.3. Submissions means submissions written including but not limited to:
- 2.4. Local and national government documents, including;
 - 2.4.1. Student related parliamentary bills;
 - 2.4.2. Student related government projects/proposals;
 - 2.4.3. Referenda;
 - 2.4.4. Dunedin City council Annual Plan;
 - 2.4.5. Otago Regional Council Annual Plan; and;
 - 2.4.6. University reports, reviews and consultative documents.

3. Membership

- 3.1. The membership of the Committee shall consist of:
 - 3.1.1. The OUSA Political Representative (chair);
 - 3.1.2. The OUSA President;
 - 3.1.3. A Te Roopū Māori Student Representative;
 - 3.1.4. An Otago University Pacific Islands' Students' Representative;
 - 3.1.5. The membership in 3.1.1, 3.1.2, 3.1.3 and 3.1.4 will be appointed by the Executive.
 - 3.1.6. There can be up to 5 (five) other general members;
 - 3.1.7. Any other OUSA members or persons appointed by the OUSA executive or coopted by the Committee.
 - 3.1.7.1. The general membership of the Committee shall be appointed by the Political Representative for a particular submission.
 - 3.1.7.2. General members who will be on the committee for longer than a particular submission will be appointed by the Executive.

4. Terms of Reference

- 4.1. The OUSA Submissions Committee shall discuss and provide advice to the Political Representative in relation to submissions.
- 4.2. All submissions shall be circulated around the submissions committee members for feedback. The committee shall then meet as required
 - 4.2.1 The submissions committee need not meet before a submission is made provided the committee expresses unanimous support for submission after circulation
- 4.3 Minutes shall be taken at each committee meeting and presented to the next available Executive meeting.
- 4.4 A submission shall only be submitted upon approval by the Executive
